What happens if my checked bag gets lost?

You are entitled to reimbursement if your luggage is misplaced, damaged, or arrives at the airport late. The airline may also compensate you for replacement and 'emergency' purchases. You can only make claims for emergency purchases made while you are without your luggage if it is delayed.

This entitlement to reimbursement encompasses package and business travel, as well as any instances in which the airline is responsible for problems involving your luggage while you are traveling. Package travelers may also be eligible for a discount for each day they are inconvenienced through baggage issues.

How should one proceed in the instance of misplaced luggage?

Before claiming lost luggage, you have to wait for another 30 to 40 minutes for the baggage to arrive. In the instance it gets misplaced, make sure to examine the nearby carousels and the area beyond your designated baggage claim zone. There are certain actions you can take to assist in getting your bag back if you can't find it yet.

You can head to the airline desk and provide the representative there with the information about the baggage. Try to be as specific as you can while presenting information. You must consider the material, any rips or tears, certain colors or patterns, and any other distinctive features of your baggage.

Check your address and contact information as well. This will allow your luggage to be delivered to you properly in the instance that it is discovered.

What steps should be taken to get my missing luggage reimbursed?

The following are the procedures for submitting a claim for **lost luggage reimbursement**:

- You have to report to the agent at the baggage desk immediately.

- In the instance that they fail to locate your luggage, they are entitled to refund you.
- You may track the whereabouts of your luggage for seven days. Following that, you can ask for a reimbursement.
- This streamlines the process of retrieving your misplaced luggage.

How to check the current flight status online?

- Visit the official website of your designated airline.
- The Flight Status tab must then be selected.

- In the instance that your booked flight is delayed, 'delayed' will appear in front of it.

What is the Compensation policy for the delayed or canceled flight?

- If your flight is delayed more than three hours without any notification from the airline, you have the right to receive a full refund and reimbursement for any inconvenience.
- If a medical problem delays the flight and causes the passengers to miss it, the airline will not be held liable for the missed trip.
- If the carrier caused the delay and the passengers missed their connecting flight, then the airline will merely book another flight.
- If there is a technical issue that causes the aircraft to be delayed for more than three hours, the passengers are entitled to a full refund as well as compensation for their inconvenience.
